

LIMITED LICENSE AGREEMENT

THIS LIMITED LICENSE AGREEMENT dated the ____ day of _____, 2010, between the CENTRAL BUCKS CHAMBER OF COMMERCE, a Pennsylvania non-profit corporation with offices at Bailiwick Office Campus, Suite No. 23, 252 W. Swamp Road, Doylestown, Pennsylvania 18901 ("CBCC") and _____ residing at _____ ("Film Maker").

BACKGROUND

CBCC is engaged in the promotion of its member organizations and in the development of programs that further the arts and humanities to improve the quality of life in the Bucks County community. Film Maker submitted an original film or video in the Bucks Fever Short Film Fest Competition entitled _____ (the "Work"). In consideration for CBCC's promotion of the Work, Film Maker hereby grants CBCC a limited, non-exclusive license for the use of the Work under the terms and conditions stated herein.

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the foregoing premises and the mutual covenants hereinafter set forth and other valuable consideration, intending to be legally bound hereby, the parties agree as follows:

1. Copyright. Film Maker warrants and represents to CBCC that s/he alone created the Work, possesses unencumbered title thereto and has the right to enter into this Agreement with CBCC. Film Maker further warrants and represents that the Work is original and does not infringe upon the title, literary or musical property or copyright of any other work or statutory, common law or other rights (including rights of privacy) of any person, firm or corporation. All rights not specifically granted to CBCC herein are expressly reserved to Film Maker. Film Maker agrees to indemnify, defend and hold CBCC, Comcast Corporation and/or any entity controlling, controlled by, or under common control with Comcast and/or Comcast Corporation harmless in the event that any claim, action, proceedings or other challenge arising out of or relating to Film Maker's warranty with respect to ownership is raised by a third party.
2. No Edit. CBCC shall not have the right to edit or excerpt from the Work except with the written consent of Film Maker. Notwithstanding the foregoing, CBCC shall have the right to excerpt up to five (5) minutes of running time from the Work solely for the purpose of promoting and advertising the Work, or publicizing the activities of CBCC. On all broadcasts or showings of the Work (except up to sixty (60) seconds of the five (5) minutes of running time for publicity uses referred to above), the credit and copyright notice supplied by Film Maker shall be included.
3. Publicity. Film Maker authorizes CBCC to use Film Maker's name, likeness and approved biographical material solely in connection with publicizing the broadcast of the Work or the activities of CBCC.
4. Limited License. Film Maker further grants to CBCC the non-exclusive right to screen the Work at any public or private exhibitions and re-record for sale by CBCC all or part(s) of the Work for non-profit fund raising and non-commercial, promotional use. No copy of the Work shall be knowingly sold, distributed or leased by CBCC to a third party for further exploitation or public distribution, without prior written consent from Film Maker.
5. Tape Costs. All copies of the Work ("Copies") shall be made at CBCC's cost from the master tape. It is understood that the master tape will remain Film Maker's property and in his/her control, provided that it shall be used as necessary by CBCC to make copies of the Work under the terms

of this Agreement. Each Copy shall bear a copyright notice in Film Maker's name and shall include such credits and acknowledgements as Film Maker deems appropriate.

6. Assignment. CBCC agrees that neither this Agreement nor any rights granted hereunder may be assigned without the prior written consent of Film Maker.

7. Term. The non-exclusive license for the use of the Work described above relating to non-profit fundraising and non-commercial, promotional use by CBCC in Section 4 only shall not terminate, but shall be of an indefinite term.

8. Binding. This Agreement shall be binding upon the parties and their respective heirs, executors, personal administrators, successors and assigns.

9. Arbitration. CBCC and Film Maker agree to arbitrate any claim, dispute, or controversy arising out of or in connection with this Agreement, or any breach thereof, before an agreed upon independent arbitrator, or, if no arbitrator can be agreed upon, before the American Arbitration Association in Bucks County, Pennsylvania, under its Rules. The decision of the arbitrator(s) shall be binding, final and nonappealable and may be entered in any court of competent jurisdiction.

10. Integration; No Amendment. This Agreement expresses the entire understanding between CBCC and Film Maker with respect to the ownership, distribution and marketing of the Work and the Copies and it supersedes all oral understanding and prior written agreements concerning the Work and the Copies. This Agreement may not be modified, amended or changed except by a writing signed by both parties.

11. Governing Law. This Agreement and the rights and duties of the parties hereto shall be construed, governed and interpreted under the laws of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania applicable to agreements made and to be performed solely within such Commonwealth.

12. Captions. Titles and captions of or in this Agreement are inserted only as a matter of convenience and for reference and in no way affect the scope or intent of this Agreement.
